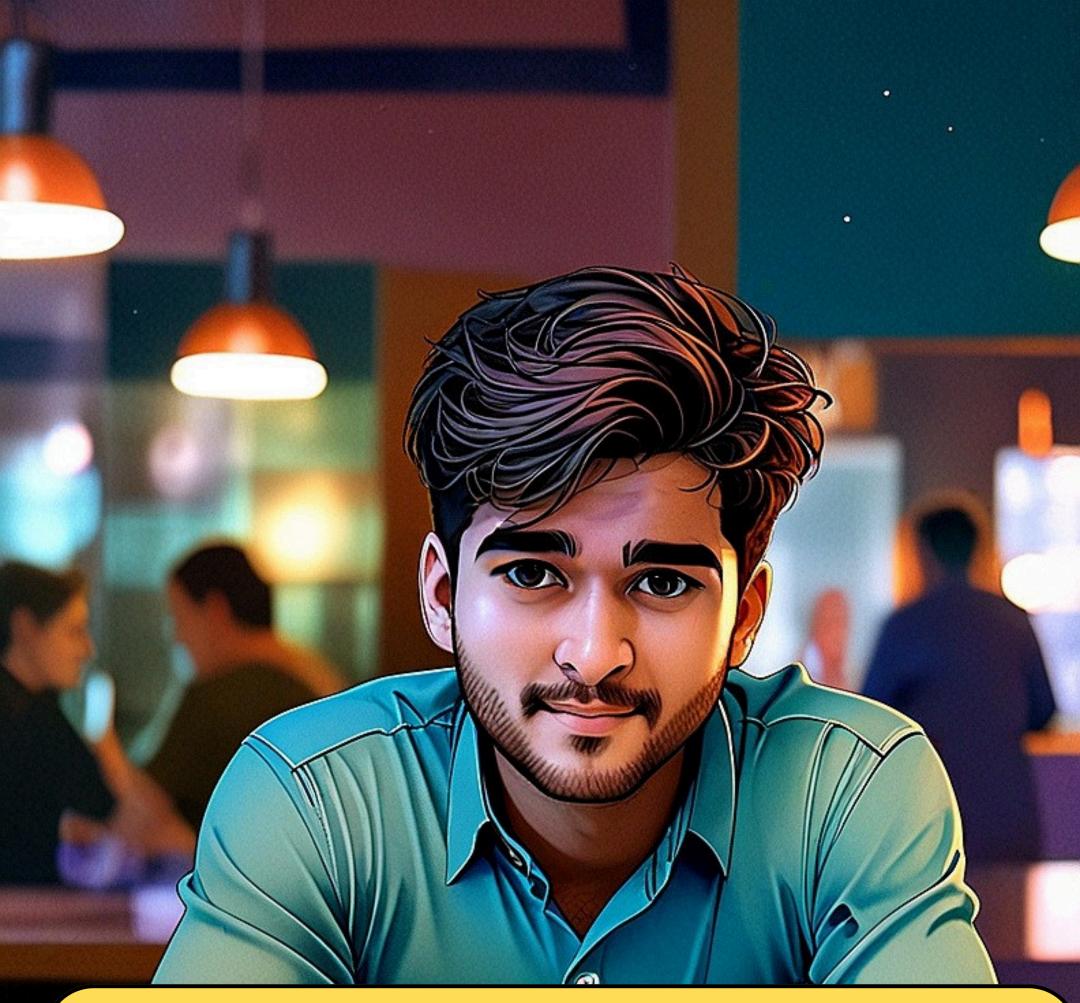

Recruiters love seeing measurable results. How many bugs did you fix? How much time did you save? Put those







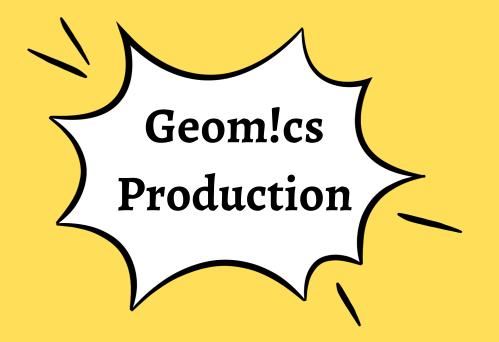


"That's like going to a party and standing in the corner! Start engaging. Share your knowledge, comment on posts, and connect with people in your field."
