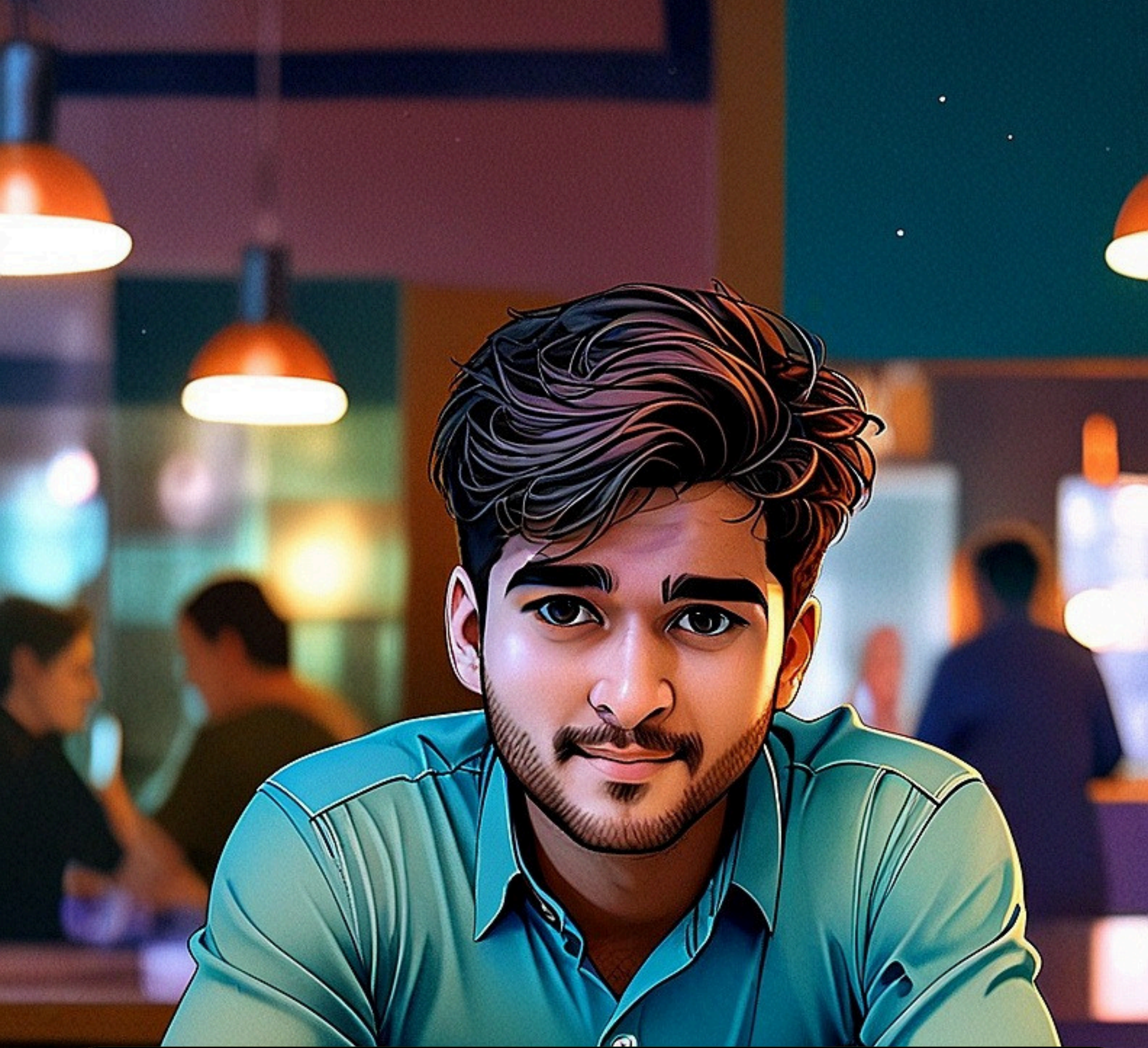




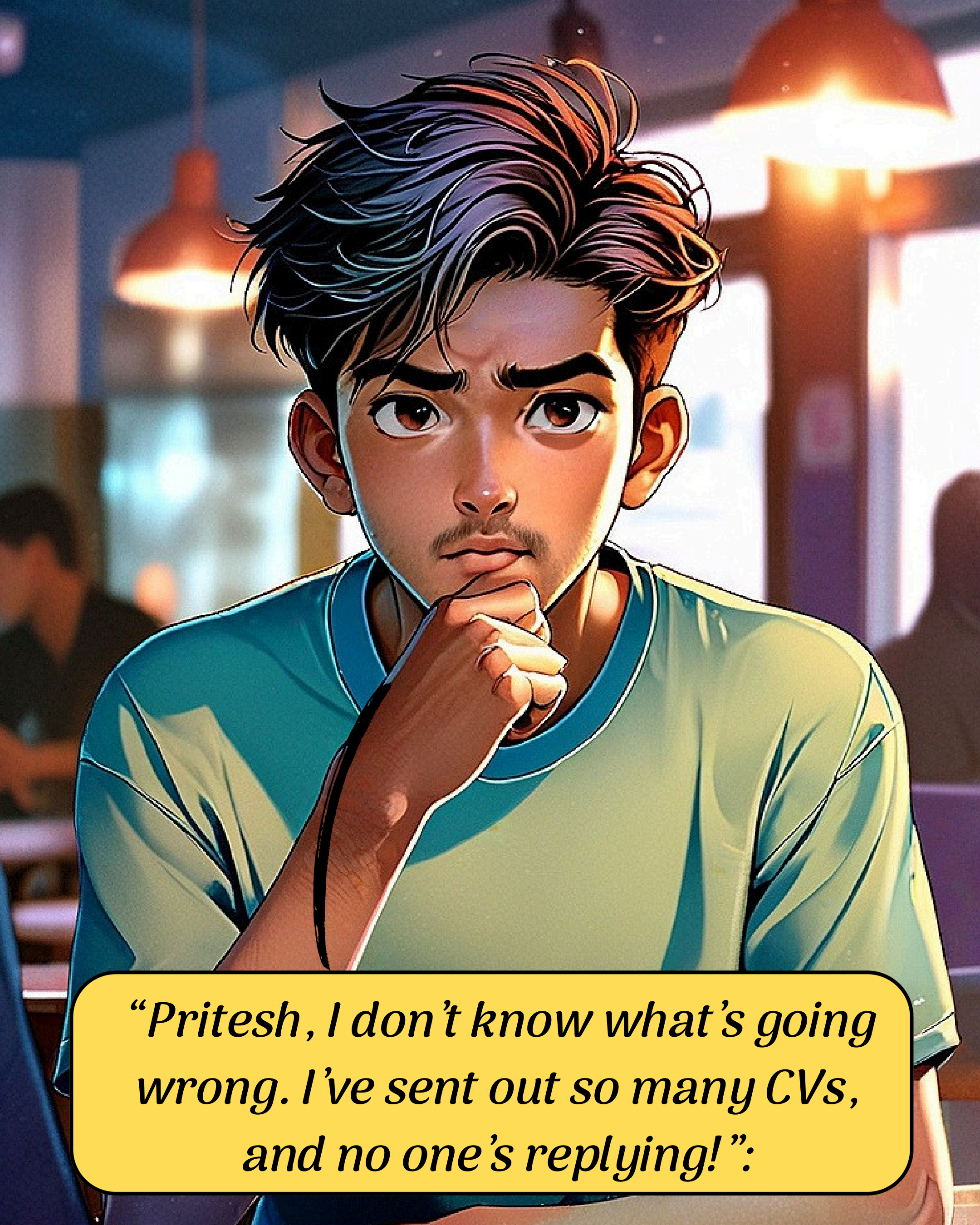

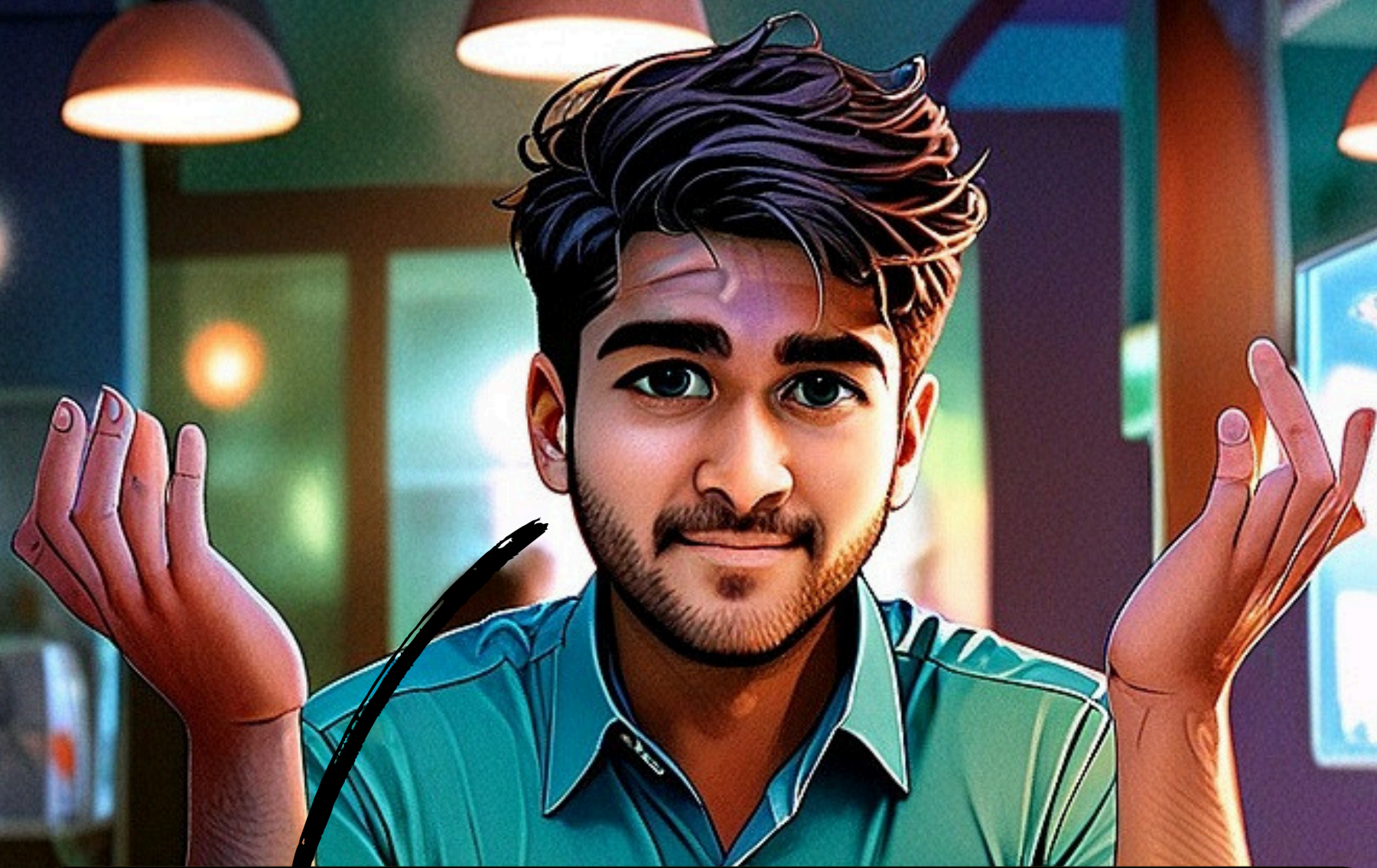

“That’s your first problem. Think of your CV as a pitch. Would you use the same pitch for every customer?”



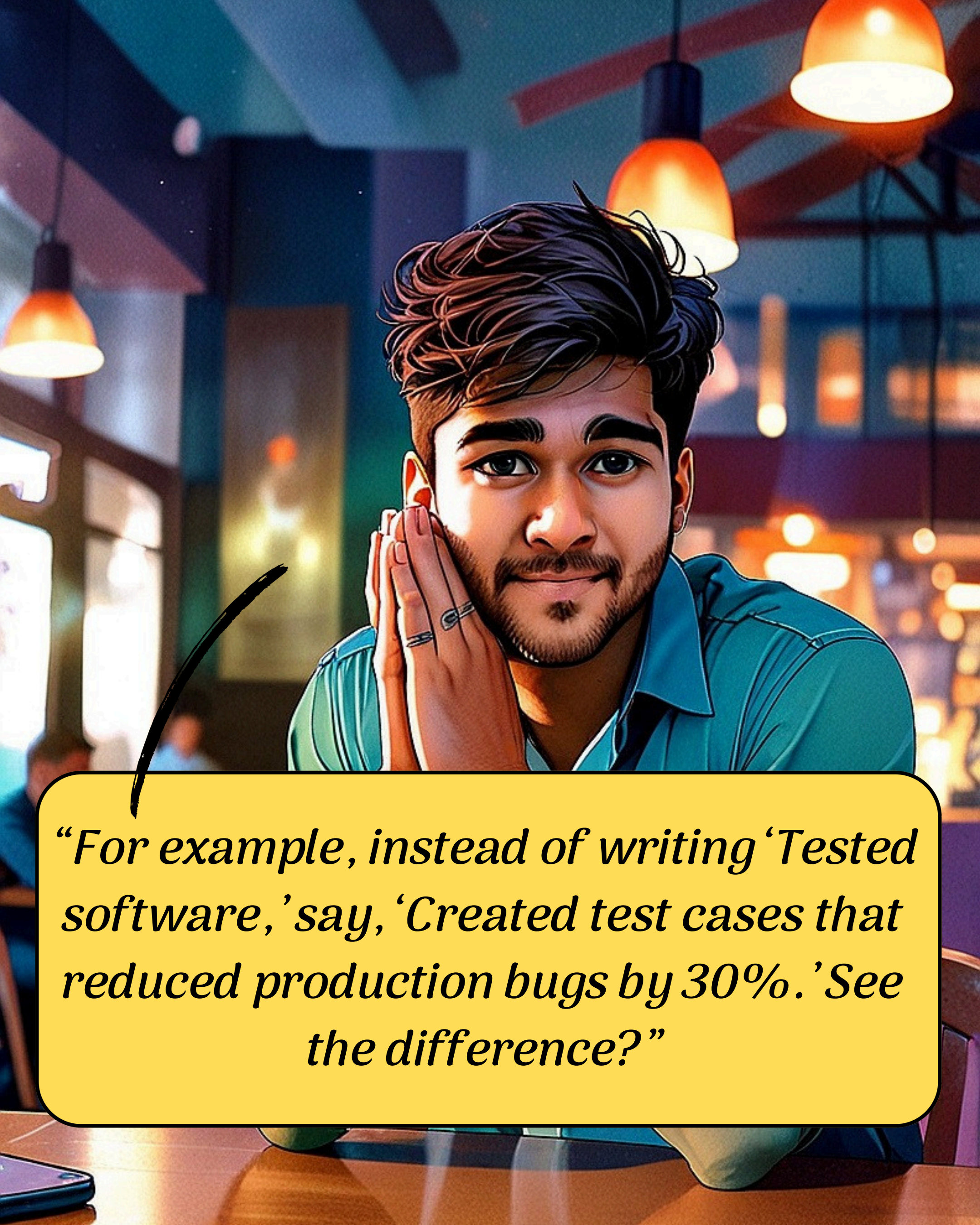
“Ohhhh, so I need to tweak it depending on the job?”



“Exactly. Highlight the skills and achievements that match the job description. And don’t just list responsibilities—focus on what you accomplished.”



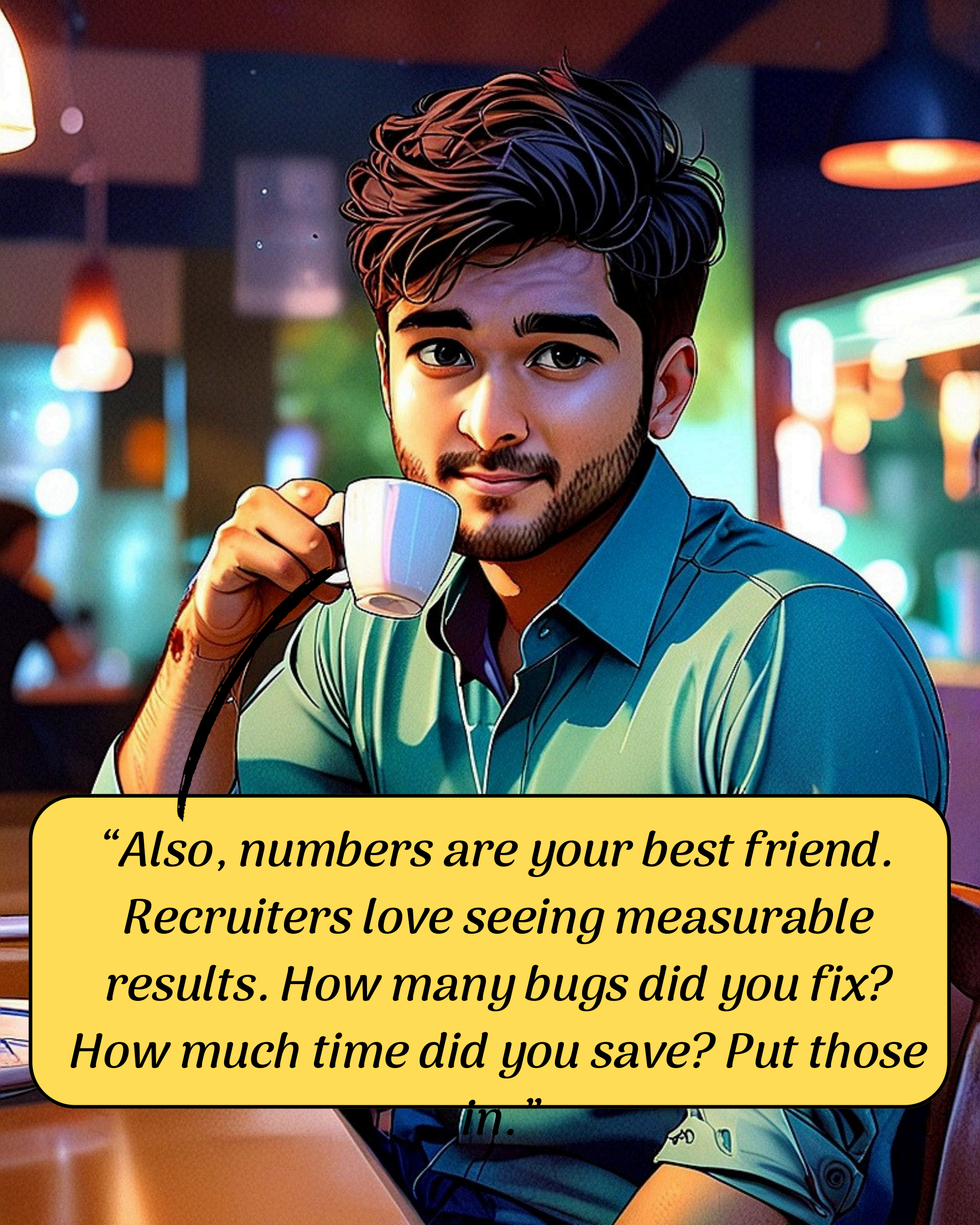
*“What do you mean by

“Uh... not really. I just scroll sometimes.”



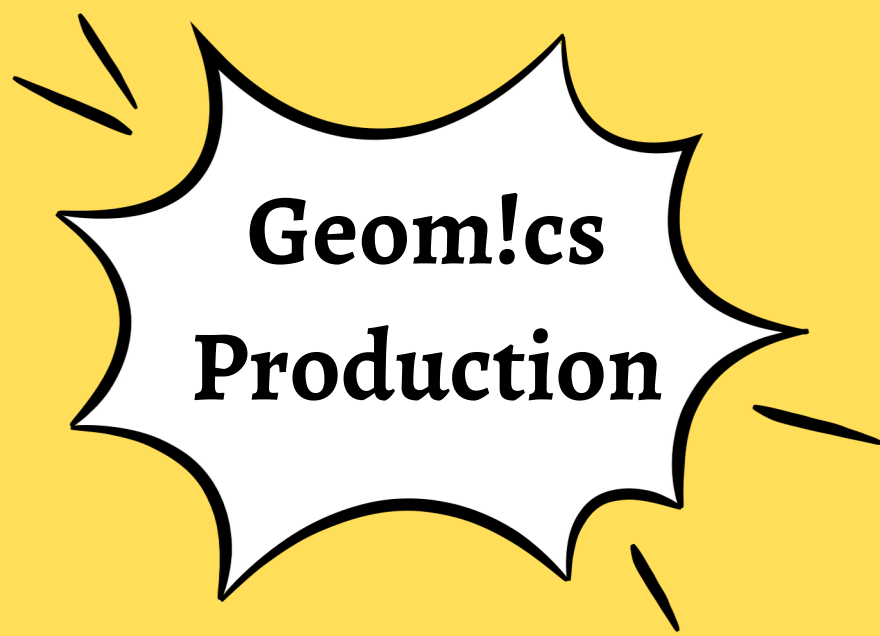
“That’s like going to a party and standing in the corner! Start engaging. Share your knowledge, comment on posts, and connect with people in your field.”
